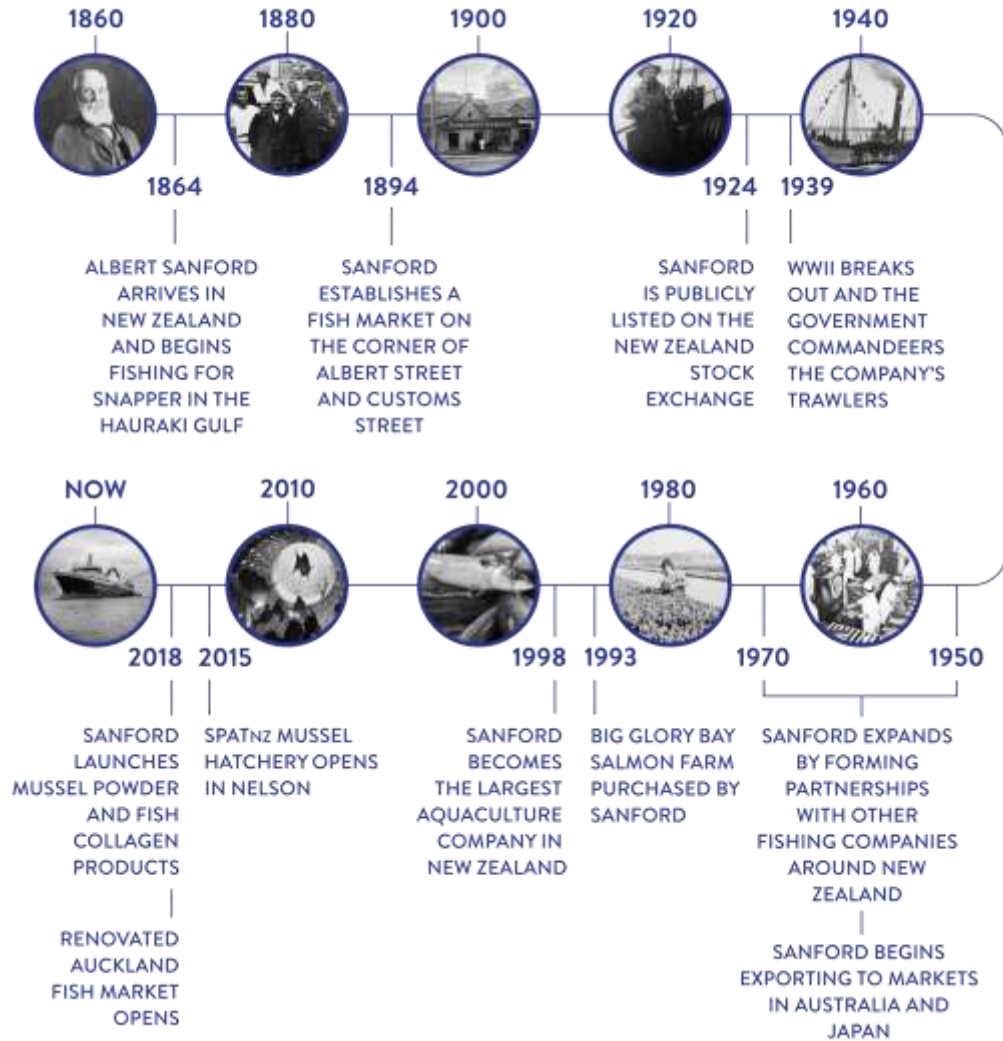

More than 150 years ago, our founder Albert Sanford went fishing for snapper in the Hauraki Gulf...

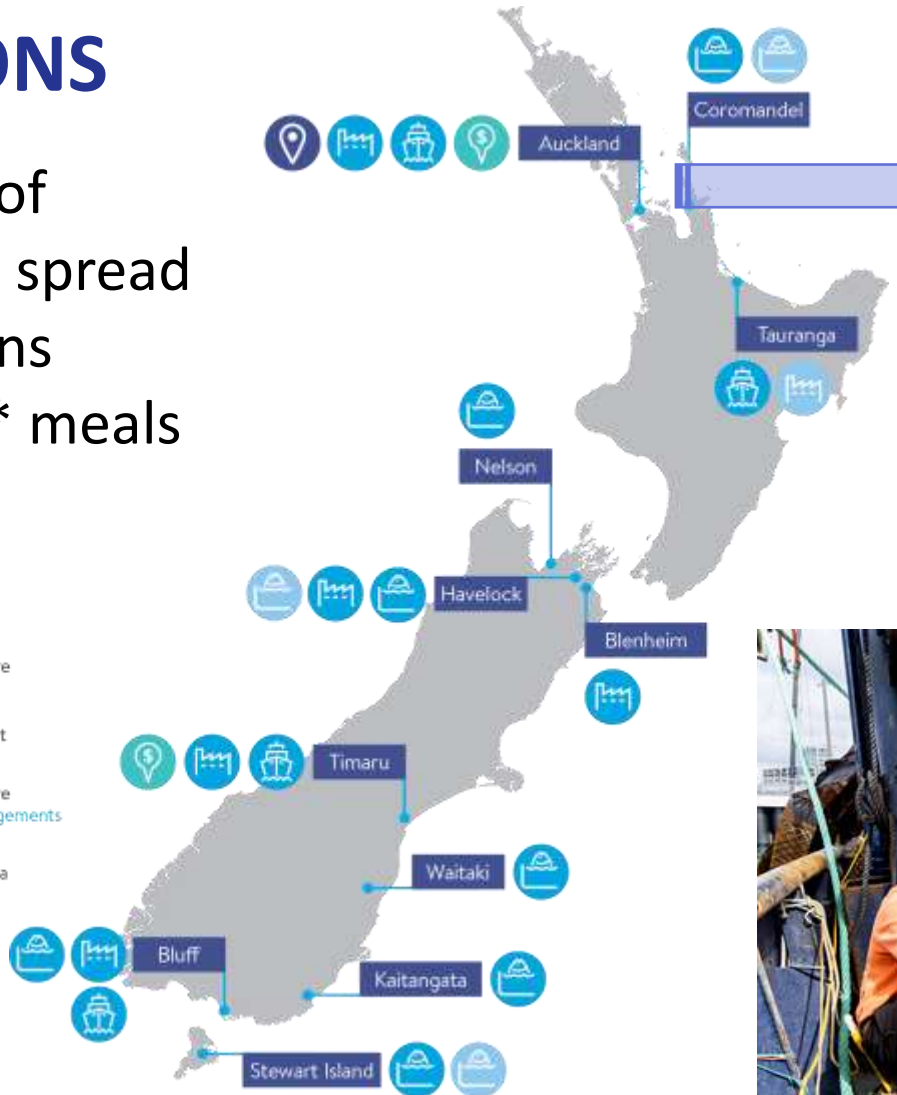


OPERATIONS

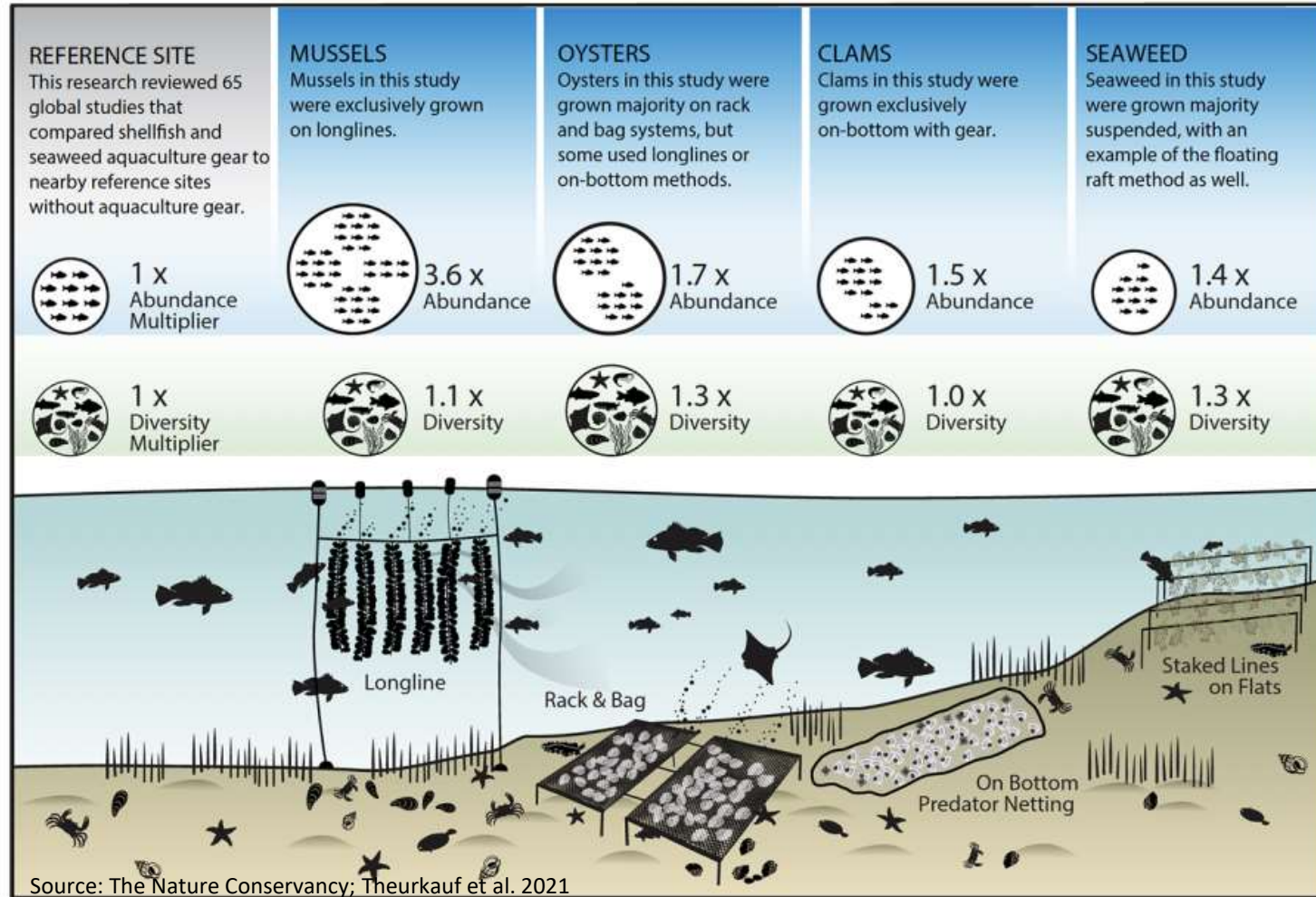
